Check in with Student Activities to join at least one club or organization
Check in with Center for Service and Social Action to participate in at least one volunteer or service experience
Check in with your Assistant Dean and Academic Advisor and attend "Meet Your Major" events
Register for a Career Education course (CE 111 for exploring students or CE 101 for students who have decided upon a major)
Visit the Career Center and find out where you are in your career development; ask to take the "Do What You Are" assessment
Connect assignments, papers, speeches, and projects to your field of interest - it's a great way to start exploring these areas and developing expertise in a field while completing your assignments at the same time!
Attend information sessions, networking events, and workshops to gather insight and advice from successful people - check Career Connection for upcoming events
Attend the Career Fair in the spring – you do NOT need to be ready to apply for a position - attending will give you a chance to observe and prepare for future events
Check Career Connection for part-time work, summer jobs and internships



PATHWAY TIMELINE

September/October

- Register for a Career Education Course (CE 101 or CE 111)
- Meet with your Academic Advisor/Assistant Dean
- Attend Student Involvement Fair to join a group of interest
- Identify part time jobs through Career Connection or Financial Aid

January/February

- Check in with Academic Advisor/Assistant Dean
- Talk to older students about their experiences and major decision making
- Consider taking "Do What You Are" at the Center for Career Services
- Attend and Observe Career Fair

November/December

- Connect assignments, papers and research to areas of career interest
- Focus on exams and building a good GPA and Standards of Academic Progress
- Utilize learning commons for peer-to-peer support
- Reflect on first semester and set goals for second term

March/April/May

- Study and Maintain GPA
- Register for CE Course
- Make an appointment with Career Assistant for new resume
- Complete your profile on Career Connection and search for summer employment
