7. Athletics Overview – Jane Evans

- **a.** There are 31 full-time, 49 part time, and 13 graduate assistant employees that service 23 varsity teams. This is a significant number of programs for a university of our size.
- **b.** There are approximately 600 student athletes each year, while 30% of each incoming class intends to play a varsity sport.
- **c.** Athletics is proud to collaborate well across campus, working closely with Enrollment, Financial Aid, the Registrar, Dining Services, Residence Life, Facilities, CSSA, etc.
- d. As a Division III school, financial aid is not awarded for athletics participation.

8. Sustainability & Housekeeping Overview – Rory Hill & Andrew Fronczek

- a. Recycling
 - i. There have been a number of changes with housekeeping services in the past year.
 - ii. There are over 50 special compartmentalized waste containers around campus that offer the opportunity to sort waste.
 - iii. Plans are being made to implement recycling systems in classrooms, departments, and outdoors.
 - iv. The dining hall has its own system for composting but it's currently being evaluated, as we do not produce enough waste for it to be picked up by the company being used.
 - v. Advice to staff who want to make sure items are recycled is to take items to the public areas where the compartmentalized containers are.
- b. Housekeeping / office cleaning
 - i. Schedule is listed online under Facilities—Housekeeping..
 - ii. Each office should ideally be cleaned once each week; some are cleaned every day, some are rarely cleaned.
 - iii. Current provider is under evaluation.
 - iv. Rory and Andrew plan to begin walk-throughs on a weekly basis to see how things are going for each office.
 - v. Staff are encouraged to email Andrew and Rory directly (<u>rhill@jcu.edu</u>, <u>afronczek@jcu.edu</u>) with comments or concerns about how their offices are being cleaned.
 - vi. One issue is that housekeeping staff are currently doing nighttime room set-ups, which are provided free of charge to those who request them. They may start charging for special setups and departments will be encouraged to set up on their own if possible.
